All items will be on loan for this exhibit. We have a secure building with security cameras. We will have additional insurance coverage for this event.

EXHIBITION

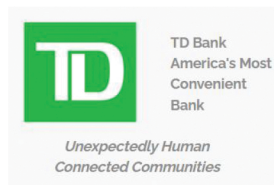
